

Did crime improve in public housing while she was Chairman?

From 2003-2006, while Trudy was Chairman, police data indicates that crime on HACA properties actually decreased. From 2003-2005, the Police Department's 2005 Annual Report stated: "In reviewing the 2005 crime statistics for the HACA properties it was noted that we are experiencing a significant decrease in crimes on public housing over the past three years." From 2005-2006, a detailed analysis of Part I crime data obtained from the Annapolis Police Department shows that crime on HACA properties decreased by another 10.5%. However, as Trudy has consistently indicated, crime during this period probably was under-reported due to the low-level of policing on public housing properties.
